

**There are a lot of exciting changes on the horizon for the Club this year. However, there will be an impact on Members as a result. Please read below to learn about what the facility renovations will mean for your outdoor tennis season at the Tecumseh Tennis Club in 2024.**

**Q: When will the Club open this year?**

*A: The Club is estimated to open sometime in July 2024.*

**Q: What work is the Club getting done?**

*A: The work includes full reconstruction of all four tennis courts, fixing the drainage issues, leveling out the surface under the shelter, replacement of fencing, and removal of the existing light poles and installing brighter LED flood lighting. The City of Mississauga will be managing the renovations at the Club.*

**Q: Will a clubhouse be built since renovations will already be happening?**

*A: No. Building a clubhouse is a large project that will require a separate approval from the City of Mississauga and will need to be 100% funded by the Club. This project will be part of the Board's longer-term planning for the Club.*

**Q: When does member registration open?**

*A: Returning members can join starting June 1, 2024. New members can join starting June 15, 2024. Information on how to register will be found on the Club's [website](#) when it becomes available.*

**Q: Will member fees be pro-rated due to the Club opening later in the season?**

*A: No. We will keep member registration fees the same as the previous year, which are still the most inexpensive in the area. Although this will be a truncated season, members will enjoy playing at a fully renovated club when we open.*

*There are several benefits of joining the Club for the shortened season:*

- *Ensuring 'returning member' status, which gives you priority to register for the 2025 season;*
- *Ability to book private lessons with our Tennis Director;*
- *Ability to participate on our Club's league teams (all matches will be held "away" for the first half of the season);*
- *Invitation to attend our grand opening celebration with our local MPP and representatives from Ontario Trillium Foundation.*

**Q: Will your Tennis Director, Steve Theodoropoulos, be teaching before the Club opens? Can I still take lessons from him, but elsewhere?**

**Q: How can I play on a Tecumseh Tennis Club league team if the Club is closed?**

*A: Team captains will be discussing options with the league convenors to determine viability for “home” matches to be played “away” for the first half of the league season, which usually begins in May. Players must be members of our Club to play on a Tecumseh Tennis Club league team. Team captains will reach out to the membership to recruit players if league play will be possible this season. However, try outs and practices may require some creativity and accessing public courts throughout the spring.
